SUMMARY OF THE COMMITTEE'S WORK

Meetings

The committee held three meetings: November 18-19, 1992, at the National Church Center, New York, New York; June 28-30, 1993 at the Holiday Inn, Raleigh/Durham Airport, NC; September 13-15, 1993 at the Holiday Inn, Raleigh/Durham Airport, NC. Also the committee met by conference calls on two occasions.

At the first meeting, the officers of the Committee were elected, their responsibilities outlined, and two working groups were established. Bishop Harris reported for the Working Group on Receipt of Nominations. The Working Group recommended formation of two review sub-committees. One sub-committee would review proposed nominees for the Boards of the General Theological Seminary and the Church Pension Fund. The other would review proposed nominees for Executive Council and the General Board of

Examining Chaplains. Dr. McGonigle reported for the Working Group on Nominee Competencies.

The Committee was determined that the list of nominees be as inclusive as possible. The Committee was also determined to see that the Church realize that the work of the Nominations Committee is totally open to the entire Church. The Committee strove to ensure that the persons nominated have the right qualifications to serve in the capacity for which they were nominated, and have the time it will take to do the job properly.

Bishops Sanders and Harris contacted those organizations for whom nominations would be made, asking them to list the qualifications necessary, and the time demands that would be made on those who served. This information was published in the Nominations Brochure. The Committee tried to distribute the nomination form and brochure as widely as possible to aid inclusivity. The Committee also worked to make the nominations brochure as "user-friendly" as possible.

At our second meeting, all proposed nominations were reviewed by the two sub-committees. The Committee then decided to receive additional nominations, with a deadline of August 16, 1993.

The Committee met again in September. The two sub-committees met. Each sub-committee then presented its list of potential nominees to the entire Committee. A list of nominees was then agreed upon, although some members of the committee were asked to do follow-up work.

Biographical material for all persons so nominated is appended to this report.
